

FEEDBACK ANALYSIS REPORT 2020-21






* The answer for the syllabus is challenging. The 93.3% students' reaction shows that the syllabus is relevant.




* 76.7% Students reply is `More than adequate'. It shows course is benefiting.


3. Was the Course conceptually difficult to understand?




- * 83.3% Students made their opinion that portion is covered 85 to 100%. It shows the best teaching performance.




* The 76.7% Students reaction is `excellent'. It shows the richness and worth full of library facility providing.


6. Were you able to get the prescribed reading materials?



* The 90% Students have reacted that internal assessment is improving the course grade. It focuses on the relationship between courses and Internal Assessment.




























